Of all alumni employed within 6 months of ending service, 46% of them attributed their employment to connections made during their VISTA service.

In 2017, AmeriCorps VISTA members generated

\$206 MILLION

in cash and in-kind resources to support local efforts to overcome poverty. That's more than **DOUBLE** every dollar invested in the program.

In 2017, AmeriCorps VISTA members mobilized

800,000+

volunteers, who collectively volunteered more than **8 MILLION HOURS** of time.

veterans and military families received assistance.
